 - A description of the proposed project. For example, if the project proposes the creation of an event, where will it be held? How will it be publicized? How much advanced planning and preparation will be needed?
 - A statement on how the proposed project will raise awareness and demonstrate the importance of being vigilant against hatred, and the necessity of speaking out instead of remaining silent.
 - An explanation of the skills that you have that will help you implement your project.
 - An approximate timeline for the project, through its completion date.
